DID YOU KNOW...

Lutheran World Relief has been serving people across the globe for 80 years? It was founded by a group of Lutherans at the end of WWII. Most recently, within the past year, they have had a significant expansion to serving those in need here in the United States. They have served those in need after Hurricane Helene and Milton, the wildfires in California, flooding in central Texas, and the effects of severe weather across the South and Midwest. Over \$1 million dollars in cash grants were distributed as well as 21 shipping containers of quilts and kits through their Quilt and Kit Ministry. Throughout the world in 2025, 803,181 Quilts and Kits were distributed to 15 countries. Kits provided include personal care, baby care, school kits, and fabric kits.
